By the mid-1760s, when Josiah Chowning opened his tavern, local leaders had begun to promote Virginia products. "An act for encouraging the making Wine," passed by the General Assembly in 1769, approved establishing a vineyard near Williamsburg. Today Chowning's Tavern offers a fine selection of domestic and imported wines.

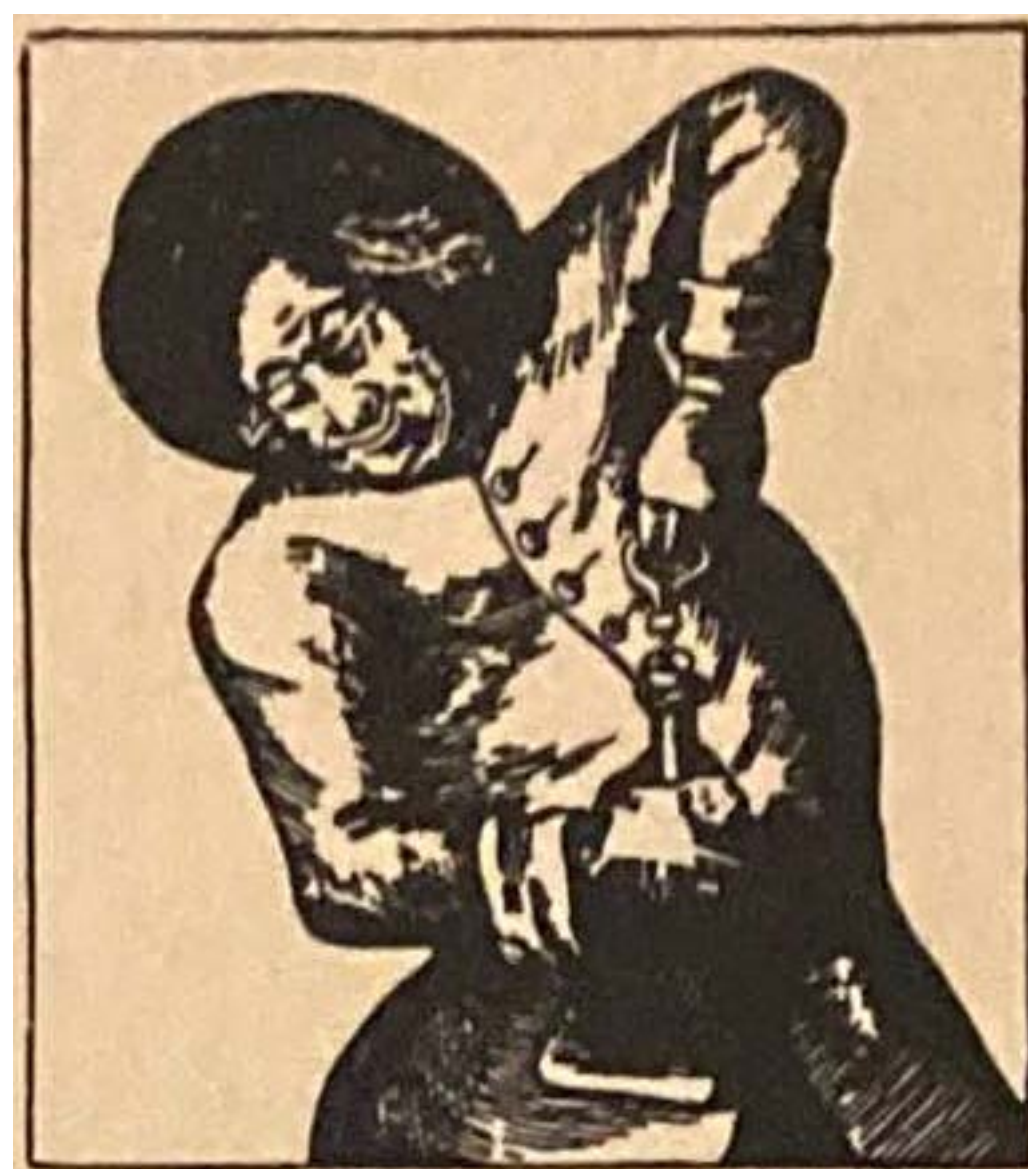
