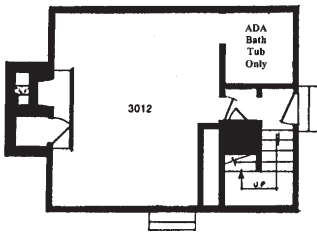


BRACKEN KITCHEN

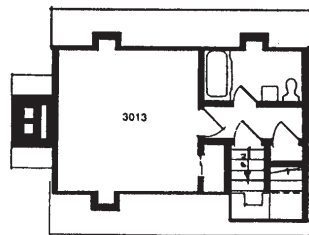
The Bracken Kitchen was a part of the extensive real estate holdings of the Rev. John Bracken. It is located on East Francis Street. Eighteenth-century kitchens were detached from the main house to prevent the spread of food odors and extreme heat and to reduce the risk of fire.

The first-floor room has a queen canopy bed. This room is ADA compliant for wheelchair accessibility. The second floor has twin beds. The pitched roofline creates a unique atmosphere in this room. Both rooms have private, full bath facilities.
