



DAVID MORTON HOUSE

The David Morton House is located on the corner of Waller Street and York Street, near Christiana Campbell's Tavern. William Lewis once operated a store on this site owned by Benjamin Waller. Tailor David Morton acquired the property, and he and his family lived here until his death in 1800.

The first-floor suite has a queen canopy bed and a sitting room with a fireplace and queen sleeper-sofa. The suite has a private, full bath. The second floor also has a queen canopy bed and a sitting room with a twin daybed with a trundle. The private, full bath is accessed from the hall.
