



GEORGE JACKSON HOUSE

The George Jackson House is located on York Street near Christiana Campbell's Tavern. The lot was owned by Benjamin Waller. George Jackson bought the property in 1773 or 1774 and operated a shop from the attached wing. Jackson risked his life during the American Revolution by chartering a ship and running gunpowder from Bermuda for the American forces.

The first-floor suite has a queen canopy bed, sitting room with a queen sleeper-sofa, and private, full bath. The second floor has a queen canopy bed and sitting room with a twin daybed with trundle. The private, full bath is accessed from the hall.
