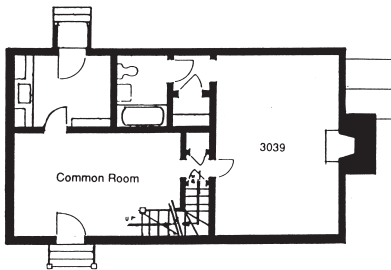




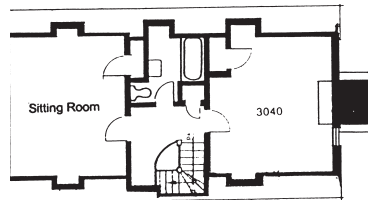
LEWIS HOUSE

The Lewis House was a part of the property owned by Orlando Jones, grandfather of Martha Washington. It is located on the corner of East Francis Street and Colonial Avenue. Charles Lewis purchased the Francis Street corner of the property. The house was modest and was torn down and another was erected using the original chimney and foundations. During the restoration, the architects reconstructed the house as accurately as possible on the original foundations.

The first floor has a common living room for all occupants to use. The bedroom has a queen canopy bed, fireplace, and private, full bath. The second floor suite has twin beds and a sitting room with a twin daybed and twin trundle. The private, full bath is accessed in the hall.
