



EWING HOUSE

The Ewing House on East Francis Street was named for Scottish immigrant Ebenezer Ewing. He lived with Elizabeth Ashton and their son Thomas. Ewing specified in his will that, if Elizabeth married after his death, the house would go to Thomas. Elizabeth never married.

The first-floor suite has a queen canopy bed and a sitting room with a fireplace and queen pull out sofa bed. The second floor has two rooms, one with a queen bed and one with two twin beds. Each of the three rooms has private, full bath facilities.
